As we begin the Lent we are called to take time to pray and reflect on our lives. Jesus went to the desert for 40 days and was tempted by Satan himself. But we are also reminded that we are not alone in our prayer and reflection. God made a covenant with Noah that established a relationship with our ancestors in faith and therefore with us.
