All Are Welcome!



Speak out boldly in the name of Jesus! When Archbishop O'Brien confirmed the young people of our parish, he challenged them to stand for something. He told them that it was often uncomfortable to stand out but that's exactly what they were doing when they were choosing to be confirmed. In the early days of Christianity, the disciples had to be careful of speaking out because it could mean their life. Today we are blessed to live in a country that values freedom of speech and religion. Yet, we are often hesitant to speak out in the name of our faith. We have to stand for something if we are faithful people. Take time this week to notice how your faith informs your decisions (both controversial and routine). Do you speak out boldly in the name of Jesus?
