

## From Barbara...

Give yourself to God. That's the theme for the Archbishop's Annual Appeal. It could also be the theme for today's readings. God takes care of those whom he loves. If we trust in God we have no worries. Even the weakest and least of all creatures are watched over and taken care of by God. But we are also stewards of God's gifts to us. We have been given the responsibility and privilege of taking care of all of God's creation including other human beings. Take time this week to consider your gift to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal that will go a long way in serving the People of God.

Lent begins next week. As we begin to prepare for the season I thought I would share with you a reflection from the pastor of St. Anthony's in 1932, Fr. J Leo Barley. I think it applies to us today as well:

Lent is a time of mortification and prayer and the occasion for a real looking into one's self to see how the affairs of the soul stand. During the Holy Season, therefore, do your very best, first to observe the fast as far as its law applies to you personally; secondly, at the cost of some real sacrifice do some real praying. Set out from the very start to take the Holy Season seriously and get out of it some benefit for yourself spiritually. If you are excused from fast some added exercise of piety should recommend itself, such as frequent reception of Holy Communion, daily assistance at Holy Mass, daily spiritual reading and the Rosary and the like.

May God continue to bless us all.
