From now until Pentecost our first readings will be from the Acts of the Apostles. These readings tell the story of the early Christian communities; how they prayed, how they shared their gifts, and how they came to form the early church. We can learn a lot from these readings for our faith communities today. For example, the last two lines of today's reading are: "They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved." In many ways the responsorial psalm sums it up - "Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting." Take time this week to be aware of how your faith can influence the people around you and have them saying to themselves, how can I share in that faith.
