Today's Gospel is one of my 2 favorite gospel stories (the other being the Transfiguration.) The Emmaus Gospel is the story of a journey that is so prevalent in the gospels. It can be applied to our faith lives. All of us are on a journey. At any point on our faith journey we can probably place our selves in this story. When we are confused we would identify with the two disciples at the beginning of the journey, unsure of what is happening and how it's going to end up. When we recognize God's presence in our lives we are rejoicing that we've been blessed and run to share our good news. When we are in need of comfort, we may listen to those (sometimes strangers) who give us insight into the situation. Take time this week to reflect on this gospel and see how it reflects your faith journey. Determine where you may be on your faith journey today, then reflect again in a month and see if it has changed.
