

Department 5 – Swine

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The Open Swine show is cancelled due to the Swine Exhibition Rules required by the PA Department of Agriculture concerning the African Swine Fever General Quarantine.

See **General Livestock information.** Entry fee: **Adult: \$4.00 per animal; Youth: Free (Sponsored by AgChoice)**
Health Requirements.

1. All show swine must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) **issued within 14 days of the Fair.**
2. All swine must be permanently identified by an official 840 series radio frequency identification (RFID) ear tag and the ear tag number must be recorded on the CVI.
3. All swine must have been visually inspected and found to be free of signs of contagious disease immediately prior to unloading at the Fair by an accredited veterinarian or swine health monitor (SHM) appointed by the Fair Board.
4. For a list of vaccination requirements for out-of-state animals call the Fair office.

General Rules:

1. All livestock must be shown by the exhibitor that it is registered under unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the class and then one animal must be shown by the registered exhibitor.
2. Exhibitors will be limited to two animals in each class except for group classes. The limit per group classes is one group per exhibitor. **No market animal may be dual entered as a breeding animal for any species.**
3. No equipment, feed, hay, bedding, etc. will be allowed to be stored in pens in the barns. These items must be kept in trailers.
4. All swine must be registered, and papers must be presented at time of entry.
5. **The Livestock Entry Form can be found at the back of this book or on the Premium Book page on the web site at www.southmountainfair.com and must be returned to the South Mountain Fair by July 6, no exceptions.**
